GENERAL INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Product evaluation and approval for anchors has not been mandatory in Dade County since December 31, 1997. To confirm this, please contact the Miami Dade Building Code Compliance Office in Miami, Florida at (305) 375-2902.

Building inspectors in Florida may request information to demonstrate compliance with local building codes. To accommodate such requests, Powers Fasteners, Inc. has the following approvals and listings available that comply with the current building code requirements:
